The Race

The marathon is open to runners of all abilities and we welcome both novices and experienced athletes to take part.

For those either not yet ready for a marathon or prefer the shorter distances we've included a Team Relay, allowing teams of four runners to participate on the same route as the marathon at the same time.

The Route

The start and finish are in the centre of the City, and the scenic City route follows large, closed and predominantly flat roads and visits some of the areas most well known and iconic locations including the Humber Bridge (the route crosses the bridge), The Marina, The Deep, and home of The Tigers the KC Stadium.

With a lap of the City centre at the start and finish of the race, and an accessible course there are plenty of opportunities for friends and family to watch the action.
